### Residence room cleanup:

Students are expected to leave residence rooms clean and undamaged. A room assessment will be conducted after move-out and charges will be applied if there are damages or if extra cleaning is required. Please note that students with outstanding charges on their student account will not be able to access their final marks. In order to maintain a quiet study environment, **students are required to vacate Residences no later than 24 hours after completing their last exam.** If there is a reason that they need to stay longer, they must request approval to do so using our [Stayover Application Form](#). **All residences close at noon on April 30th.**

Meal plans will continue to be valid until noon on April 30th, however locations and hours of operation will change – please check the [Hospitality Services website](#) for details.
