



Dear residence students,

Two new positive cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed by KFLAPH in Victoria Hall and Chown Hall. These cases are connected to earlier cases identified in the current outbreak and the impacted students are isolating.

At this time there are no more floors isolating in place. All students who still require isolation are now at Smith House and will continue to be supported by the residence team. We are also continuing to work closely with KFLAPH to assist students who may wish to make safe arrangements to leave campus and complete their isolation in an alternate location.

We encourage students to get asymptomatic testing prior to travelling or returning home. Student Wellness Services has extended the hours for on campus testing through May 7. You can [book an appointment online](#) or by calling 613 533-2506.

If you are concerned that you may have been exposed to COVID-19 in your last days on campus, please note that KFLAPH continues their contact tracing efforts and if they identify you as a close contact, you will receive notification and follow-up even if you are now out of the KFLAPH jurisdiction.

**You must move out by 3 pm today unless you have an approved extension to remain in residence.** Dining halls close after the lunch service today. Rooms checks are underway; if you did not make arrangements with us for an extended stay or to have items stored or shipped to you, belongings left behind will be deemed abandoned and discarded. Please email [reslife@queensu.ca](mailto:reslife@queensu.ca) to request an extension, should you need one.

If you are remaining in residence or are returning in the next few days to pick up belongings, the Victoria Hall desk remains open for return of keys.
